On behalf of John Ross District and your Camporee Staff, we welcome you to our Spring Camporee! The Staff have spent many hours to ensure that you will not forget this event for many years to come! During this camporee you will have the opportunity to compete in the Highland Games and enjoy the great outdoors!

This is an event that is designed for Scouts of all ages, from Lion to Eagle Scout.

Each patrol will need to bring with them, besides their normal camping gear, a Clan Cheer, and a Clan Name that they will be representing. Clans will have time to construct their very own Clan flag. Awards will be given for, game winners, Scout Spirit, & Clan creativity! Scout Spirit will be based on teamwork, attitude, and participation of all members of the Clan. Cub Scouts will not be allowed to camp overnight for this event.

Awards will be presented for both Scouts, BSA and Cub Scouts, based on average scores per Clan at each event. (Cub Scouts should intermix dens for fairness. For instance, one scout from each den per Clan. Extras per Clan will be accepted as they are harder to form.) First, second, & third prizes will be available. Patches and shirts will also be given to anyone who registers **PRIOR** to March 8th. Anyone who registers after that date will not be guaranteed a patch or shirt.

For the mere cost of \$20 per scout and \$12 per leader, this is a bargain because you will also receive a t-shirt commemorating this epic event! Extra t-shirts can be ordered if you are interested at the cost of \$10 per shirt. The deadline for a guaranteed t-shirt at event will be March 8th. After that, we cannot guarantee that your size will be Available.

Expectations

It is to be expected that everyone participating maintain and live by the Scout Laws. Being kind and courteous is always expected. Cheering on your Clan and other Clans makes for much more fun, even though you are competing. Remember that Clans are to be "youth led" and we look forward to see your smiling faces.

Clans will be responsible for all meals. **YOUR CLANS SHOULD PLAN A QUICK LUNCH FOR GAMES ON SATURDAY** or take advantage of our concession area. We will provide a break for lunch, but it will only be for 30 minutes to accommodate the games in a timely manner.

It will be expected that each Unit participating will provide **at least 1 volunteer** to assist with the events. As you register, please state who your volunteers will be so that we can properly place you with an event.

Please turn in the Unit roster and registration that is attached to this guide to the scout service center (even if you register online) to assure you receive the correct shirts and patches, This also will expedite your check in process.

Miscellaneous Information

Medical Forms: All Scouts and Leaders must have their Part A & B medical forms on file with their unit leaders at the camporee.

Parking: Around senior center and lots closest to playing field. Please do not park at the Colonnade. No vehicles on gravel drive please.

Meals: All meals will need to be prepared within the unit campsites. Everyone, including Cub Scouts, will need to bring a quick lunch or purchase concessions on Saturday.

Camping: Troop/Crew campsites are located behind the senior center. Troop trailer entrance is on the south end of the senior center.

Campfires: Campfires are permitted within the camp sites but must be in above ground fire rings.

Emergencies & First Aid: Please carry a personal medical kit for minor boo boos. For anything major, please contact the Staff Medic. **ALL INJURIES MUST BE REPORTED TO STAFF MEDIC.**

Sanitation: The campground has wonderful facilities provided, including water which is located on the upper deck between the bathrooms. Please pack out any trash that you create while at the camporee. Your campsite is your responsibility to clean. Remember, we as scouts, like to leave a place better than what we found it!

Camporee Rules

No fireworks, firearms, or on the ground fires are permitted.

No electronics except for picture taking. Leaders may keep cell phones for emergency purposes.

We will be camping close together, please be respectful of others' campsites. Please do not mess with anything, including tents, that do not belong to you.

All Scouts will wear Class A uniforms for Campfire, Flags, and Chapel Ceremonies. Provided camporee shirts should be worn during the games. **Kilts are encouraged for this camporee.**

Please be respectful of the 10:30pm lights out.

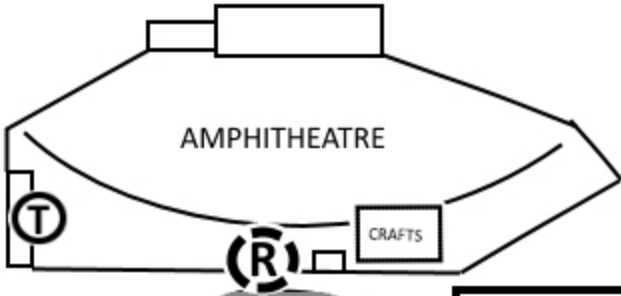
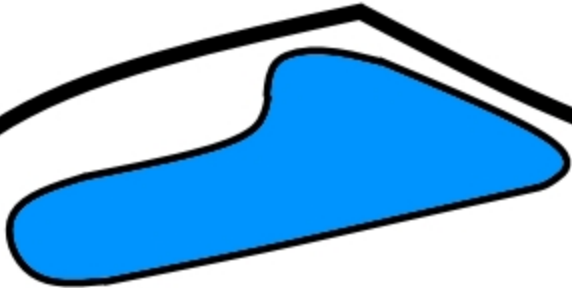
